

Leadership Challenge 1999

- I. Written solutions to the problem can be a maximum of 4 pages, and must include, in the following order:
 - a. A statement of the problem
 - b. Evidence of team brainstorming for possible solutions
 - c. An analysis of probable cause for the problem
 - d. A plan of action that indicates the goals of the team and specifies the roles of chapter officers in the plan's implementation
 - e. Steps or procedures for implementation of the plan
 - f. Possible methods for evaluating the solution

- II The oral presentation should include:

- a. State the problem
- b. Describe the final goals of the team
- c. Explain how the team plans to solve the problem
- d. Explain how the success of the team's solution can be evaluated
- e. Identify at least one point of opposition to the proposed solution and explain how the team might respond to that opposition

- II The Problem

Your chapter has 12 members wanting to attend the national conference. Final payment for the conference is three (3) weeks away, and the chapter is short \$1,200! None of the chapter members or their families can afford to pay that kind of money on their own.

Develop a plan for raising that amount of money in such a short time. Make sure that plan is realistic for the time and human resources available.
